The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 and 2 for conducting high level inquiry into the matter or to constitute special investigation team to inquire into the matter and to take legal action against the police officials who are responsible for not presenting challan/report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.205 dated 06.06.2014, registered under Sections 21 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Tarn Taran.

Notice of motion.

Mr. V.G.Jauhar, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present in court has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State.

Briefly stated, the petitioner's husband Inspector Inderjit Singh was the investigating officer in the aforesaid case. In that case challan could not be presented within a stipulated period of 180 days, therefore, the learned Judge, Special Court, Tarn Taran, vide order dated 05.12.2014 granted the bail to the accused Gurjit Singh under the provisions under Section 167 (2) Cr.P.C. However, it was ordered that the copy of the bail

order be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran as well as to the Director General of Police, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that infact the Inspector Inderjit Singh was transferred in August, 2014 and the said matter was delayed by Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran as the record was sent to him vide DDR No.18 dated 27.11.2014 (Annexure P-6(T)).

The Inspector General of Police, Punjab is directed to consider the representation (Annexure P-7) ; conduct an enquiry with regard to the delaying of the submission of final police report and in case it has been found that delay was intentional then to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
