The present application has been filed under Order 47 Rule 1 of the CPC read with Section 151 CPC seeking review of judgment/order dated 16.05.2018.

A perusal of the order judgment/order dated 16.05.2018 shows that the matter has been remitted to respondent No.2 to pass a fresh speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner in accordance with law. Needless to say that anything observed herein above shall not be taken to be an expression of opinion of the merits of the controversy.

It was contended on behalf of the applicant-review/petitioner that the order dated 15th April, 2017 (Annexure P-22) cancelling the tender granted in favour of the petitioner as well as subsequent order dated 24th November, 2017 (Annexure P-27), passed by respondent No.2 debarring the petitioner from participating in tender inquiry for a period of two years has been quashed.

On a query being put to learned counsel for the applicant-review/petitioner, as to whether the order dated 15th April, 2017 (Annexure P-22) and subsequent order dated 24th November, 2017 (Annexure P-27) had been passed after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, it was candidly admitted that it was not so.

In such circumstances, no ground for review is made out.
