Learned counsel for respondent has submitted that the matter has finally been settled between the parties.

The respondent-husband had filed a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') for seeking divorce on the ground of desertion and cruelty. The said petition was allowed vide judgement decree dated 30.01.2018. The appellant-wife has challenged the said decree by way of the present appeal but during the pendency of the appeal, parties have entered into a compromise as per which respondent has agreed to pay ₹4,00,000/- to the appellant for the withdrawal of the present appeal. It is submitted that an amount of ₹2,00,000/- has already been paid to the appellant and the remaining amount of ₹2,00,000/- shall be paid after the withdrawal of the appeal. Therefore, learned counsel for the appellant has prayed for withdrawal of the present appeal.

In view thereof, the appeal is hereby dismissed as withdrawn

with a rider that in case the respondent do not pay the remaining amount of

₹2,00,000/- to the appellant within one month, appellant shall be at liberty to file appropriate application for its revival.
