This is an application under Section 151 CPC
seeking review of the order dated 27.9.2018 passed by this
Court whereby the writ petition was allowed to be withdrawn
with liberty to avail the alternative remedies.

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner
submitted that when the writ petition came up for motion
hearing on 22.6.2018, the following order had been passed:

"xxxx xxxx xxxx

On payment of ₹70 lacs to the Bank, which shall
be kept in non-lien account, the auction salted for
26.6.2018 is ordered to be stayed. The Bank is
also directed to consider the proposal submitted
by the petitioner-guarantor for arriving at one time
settlement and also file an affidavit as to what
action has been taken for recovery of the amount
against the principal borrower."

However, after passing of the said order, thereafter the writ petition was allowed to be withdrawn with the liberty to avail alternative remedies in accordance with law vide order dated 27.9.2018.

After hearing learned counsel for the review petitioner and perusing the application for review, no ground to review the aforesaid order dated 27.9.2018 is made out.

Dismissed.
