

101 CMs-4218-4219-4220-2018 and RA-CR-37-CII-2018 in FAO-4142-2016

Vide order dated 11.12.2017, this Court had upheld the order dated 31.3.2016, passed by the lower Court exercising the powers of District Judge under the provisions of Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act and under the Guardian and Wards Act, holding that the respondent-wife is entitled to the custody of the minor child with visitation right to the appellant-father.

The present review application has been filed along with an application for additional evidence in the shape of Annexures R1 to R5, pleading that child Mayank, is more than 16 years of age and is aware of his welfare and is interested to stay with the appellant.

We have considered the averments in the review application and are of the opinion that the welfare of the child, as claimed by the appellant, has been carefully considered by us in the order dated 11.12.2017. The welfare of the child has been taken into consideration and in the interest of amicable compatibility of the child with the mother, it has been ordered that six months time would be taken by the executing Court to take suitable steps for implementation of the order. As the pleas taken up in the review petition have already been taken care of, we do not find any ground to entertain this review application and the same is dismissed.

The application for additional evidence is also dismissed as the documents sought to be placed on record were already in existence. Even otherwise, they do not seem to be relevant for the adjudication of the right of the respondent-wife under the provisions of law. With the dismissal of review application as well as application for additional evidence, the other two misc. applications i.e. application for stay of the order dated 11.12.2017 as well as application for exemption from filing certified copies of Annexures R1 to R5, are also dismissed.
