Present review application has been filed by the respondents for review of the order dated 21.11.2017. Even though, the present application is in the guise of a review petition but actually the respondents want to challenge the correctness of the order rather than pointing out any mistake in the order. The scope of this Court in review is very limited. No factual error has been pointed out, which needs to be reviewed.

In the guise of review, State counsel has tried to argue that the grant of Rs.60,000/- vide order dated 21.11.2017, is not correct and the petitioner was only entitled for a sum of Rs.5,000/- as being paid under the guidelines issued by the All India Institute of Medical Science.

I am of the view that as no factual error has been pointed out, in the order, thus review is not maintainable and the same is dismissed.
