The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 598 dated 05.11.2017, registered under Sections 365, 376 of IPC and Section 6 of the POCSO Act, Police Station Ganaur, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 02.02.2017 and the material witnesses including complainant and the victim have turned hostile. Counsel refers to Annexures P1 to P-4. Counsel further says that in the first statement there are no allegations against the petitioner, however, he was named in the second statement made under Section 164 Cr.P.C.

The State counsel has opposed the bail application but does not dispute the fact that the prosecutrix has turned hostile.

In view of the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner and
and as the trial will take long to conclude, the petition is allowed and the
petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate
personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
