On the last date of hearing Mr. Sunil Fernandes, Standing Counsel appearing for the respondent / BSES had sought time to take instructions. Proxy counsel on instructions from Mr. Sunil Fernandes, Advocate concedes that no hearing was given to the petitioner before the order dated December 22, 2017 was issued. This submission of proxy counsel is sufficient to set aside the impugned order dated December 22, 2017.
