By this petition, the petitioner seeks parole on the ground that he has to find suitable match for his daughter and to maintain social ties.

The status report has been handed over by the learned Additional Standing Counsel which is taken on record.

As per the status report it has been verified that the family of the petitioner is residing at H.No. S-2/204, 1st Floor, Old Mahavir Nagar, Tilak Nagar, Delhi. The family of the petitioner consists of his wife and two daughters aged 26 and 17 years respectively besides the son aged 23 years old who is studying in Canada.
