The present petition is filed under Section 11(5) and (6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking appointment of a sole arbitrator to adjudicate the disputes between the parties.

Some of the relevant facts are that the parties entered into an agreement on 09.05.2015 regarding construction of a residential building at Plot B-1, Section 36, Noida, U.P. Disputes having arisen between the parties, the petitioner has invoked the arbitration clause on 09.12.2017. It is also pointed out that a petition under Section 9 of the Act is also pending adjudication before another court.
