Mr. Chandra, learned counsel for the custodian submits that subsequent to the impugned order and these proceedings, the custodian has now taken cognizance and issued notice to the concerned and effected parties. It appears that the hearing was even conducted yesterday and adjourned for further proceedings. In view of these developments, learned counsel for the appellant requests that the appeal be permitted to be withdrawn granting liberty to the parties to urge all contentions. It is also submitted that the appellant's rights viz-a-viz the contentions to the validity of the execution proceedings
