By this petition the petitioner challenges the communication dated 6th December, 2017 passed by the competent authority rejecting the grant of parole to the petitioner which he had sought on the ground that he has to file special leave petition before the Supreme Court, arrange funds for the same and re-establish social ties.

A perusal of the nominal roll attached with the petition reveals that after the communication dated 6th December, 2017 rejecting parole to the petitioner, petitioner has since been granted furlough for a period of three
