ORDER

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16.03.2018

1. Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 8/2018 registered under Sections 308/34 IPC at PS Chandni Mahal. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondents No.2 to 4.

2. Respondents No.2 to 4 are present with their counsel and have been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from them if they have settled the dispute with the petitioners amicably without any fear or pressure. They have informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with their free consent and they have no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Parties are closely related to each other. Nature of injuries suffered by the victim(s) is simple. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to put an end to the litigation and to maintain their relations, FIR No. 8/2018 registered under Sections 308/34 IPC at PS Chandni Mahal and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.
4. The petitioners are directed to deposit ₹ 20,000/- as costs in the Prime Minister Relief Fund within two weeks. Registry shall ensure its compliance.
5. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
