Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that matter has been settled with the complainant. Memorandum of Understanding/Compromise Deed dated 18th April, 2018 has been placed on record. Complainant is also present in Court along with her counsel and admits that matter has been settled between her and petitioner. Petitioner has paid ₹2 lacs to the complainant vide a demand draft, photocopy where has been placed on record.
