1. This application has been filed by the petitioner stating *inter alia* that the respondent no.2 has recently issued a circular dated 06.07.2018, which provides a platform for speedy redressal of the grievances of the Force personnel.

2. Learned counsel states on instructions that the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the present petition while reserving his right to approach the respondents for redressal of his grievances in terms of the circular dated 06.07.2018.
