Mr. Sumit Bansal, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw this petition at this stage, with liberty to assail the order that may be passed by the South Delhi Municipal Corporation, in relation to his application seeking regularisation of the construction existing in the subject property i.e. Khasra No. 253 behind South Delhi Municipal Corporation, Primary

School, near Kohinoor, Farm House Saidulajab, New Delhi in the event, he is aggrieved thereby.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of South Delhi Municipal Corporation states that, subject to the petitioner furnishing all the requisite details, they shall determine his application seeking regularisation as aforestated strictly, in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from today.
