This is an application filed under Order 23 Rule 3 read with Section 151 CPC on behalf of the parties. The decree holder has filed the captioned Execution Petition seeking execution of Decree dated 17.04.2009 in C.S.(O.S) No.189/2009 titled "Shri Puneet Parkash Vs. Shri Jai Parkash & Ors." The said decree is of Partition, Rendition of Accounts and Permanent Injunction in relation to joint family properties detailed in the Plaint.
