1. Petitioner was aggrieved for the reason despite his information of a cognizable offence being given to the SHO, P.S. Economic Offences Wing, Mandir Marg, New Delhi, no FIR was registered.

2. A status report has been filed. As per the status report, the allegations of the petitioner in the complaint were that an amount of ₹6,74,25,117/- was deposited by someone in his two bank accounts with ICICI Bank Branches at Burra Bazar and Golpark, Kolkata, West Bengal. As per the status report, the complaint received at EOW on 4th December, 2017 was sent to Commissioner of Police, Kolkata, West Bengal on 13th December, 2017. It is stated that the second complaint of the petitioner received by the EOW was also forwarded to Commissioner of Police, Kolkata, West Bengal on
