Notice. Learned APP accepts notice. Respondent no.2 Ms. Parveen Kaur is present in Court and accepts notice. She has been identified by ASI Khushi Ram of police station Khyala. Respondent no. 2 admits having settled the matter with petitioner no. 1 of her own free will, voluntarily and without any undue force, pressure or coercion. Respondent no. 2 submits that her marriage with the petitioner no.1 has already been dissolved by a decree of divorce by mutual consent dated 10th January, 2018 passed by the Family Courts, West District, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi. Petitioner no. 1 has paid ₹50,000/- to the respondent no. 2, vide a demand draft, photocopy whereof has been placed on record. Respondent no. 2 says that entire settled

amount of ₹2,00,000/- stands paid with this payment and she has no objection in case FIR is quashed against the petitioner no. 1 and his relative, that is, petitioner no. 2. Affidavit of respondent no. 2 is also on record.

Keeping in mind the facts and circumstances as detailed above, more particularly, the fact that marriage of petitioner no. 1 and respondent no. 2 has already been dissolved by a decree of divorce by mutual consent, in the interest of justice, FIR No.577/2015 under Sections 498-A/406/34 IPC registered at Police Station Khyala and the consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

Petition is disposed of in the above terms. Miscellaneous application is disposed of as infructuous. Dasti.
