The application stands disposed of.

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1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.217/2016 registered under Section 498A/34 IPC at PS Dabri (South West). It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondent No.2 vide settlement agreement dated 10.02.2018.

2. Complainant / respondent No.2 is present with counsel and has been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from the

complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioners amicably without any fear or pressure. She has informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with her free consent and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question. Divorce has already been taken place. Pursuant to the settlement, ₹2 lacs (in cash) has been paid to the complainant by the petitioners in the Court today. Statement to that effect has been recorded separately.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of settlement agreement dated 10.02.2018 has been placed on record. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to settle in life after divorce, FIR No.217/2016 registered under Section 498A/34 IPC at PS Dabri (South West) and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
