the petitioner (Annexure P5 and P6) within eight weeks from today and pass an appropriate order. If considered necessary, notice shall be issued to the Society and the parties named in the petition / applications before passing appropriate orders.”

Mr. Anjum Javed, learned Addl. Standing Counsel who appears for respondent no.2 states, he has instructions to state that order shall be complied with, within a period of two weeks from today. The said statement is taken on record. If the order is not complied with within the time referred to by the learned counsel for respondent no.2 on instructions, petitioner shall be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.
