This is an application under Order XXIII Rule 3. The application is signed by the parties. On behalf of the Appellant, it is signed by Ms. Anju Bajaj and on behalf of the Respondents, Ms. Renu Chopra and Ms. Neeru Das, along with the respective counsels have also signed the application. All three parties are present in Court.

Parties submit that they resolved their disputes as per the settlement report filed by the Delhi High Court Mediation Centre dated 9th March, 2018. A memorandum of Oral Family Settlement dated 3rd March 2018,
