ORDER

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04.04.2018

(1) Present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been preferred by the petitioners for quashing of FIR No.238/2017 under Sections 326/323/506/34 IPC registered at Police Station Kalyanpuri. It is stated that the matter has been settled with the complainant/victims amicably.

(2) Respondent Nos.2 to 5 are present before the Court along with their counsel. The Investigating Officer present in the court has

identified them. I have enquired from the complainant/victims whether the matter has been settled with the petitioners amicably without fear and pressure. They have informed that the matter has been settled without any fear or pressure and they have no objection to the quashing of the FIR.

(3) The petition is supported by the affidavits of the parties. Cross-case vide FIR No.564/2017 under Sections 354/323/506/34 IPC registered at Police Station Kalyanpuri has also been settled.

(4) Since the Respondent Nos.2 to 5 have voluntarily settled the dispute with the petitioners, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to put an end to the litigation, FIR No.238/2017 under Sections 326/323/506/34 IPC registered at Police Station Kalyanpuri and all the proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

(5) The petitioners are, however, burdened with costs of ₹20,000/- to be deposited with Prime Minister National Relief Fund within two weeks. The Registry shall ensure the compliance of the order.

(6) The petition is disposed of accordingly.
