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In view of the order made on 05.04.2018 permitting judicial officers who may not have approached the Court (i.e. the Supreme Court) to appear for the Delhi Higher Judicial Service (DHJS) examination in the direct recruit quota, learned counsel appearing for the Delhi High Court establishment, on advance notice, submits that the present petitioner too would be permitted to appear.
