1. The parties have amicably settled all their disputes and filed joint application under Order XXIII Rule 3 of the Code of Civil Procedure signed by all the parties as well as their counsels. The terms of the settlement are recorded in the memorandum of family settlement dated 13th March, 2018 filed along with the application. Application is also supported by the affidavits of the parties.
2. The plaintiff, defendant No.1, defendant No.3 and attorney of defendant No.2 are present in Court and they all confirm the settlement recorded in I.A. 8821/2018.
