ORDER

1. The learned counsel for the Petitioner informs the Court that during the course of mediation, a settlement has been arrived at between the Petitioner and her husband - both of whom are present in the Court. The Settlement Agreement dated 23rd April 2018 signed by both of them before the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre has been produced before the Court. 3. The petition is disposed of in terms of the Settlement Agreement dated 23rd April 2018 which shall form of the present order. Liberty is granted to the parties to approach the Court if there is any difficulty faced by them in working out the terms of settlement.
