W.P.(CRL) 1221/2018

1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for quashing of FIR No. 444/2016 registered under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC at PS Bharat Nagar. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondent No.2.

2. Complainant / respondent No.2 is present and has been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from the complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioner amicably without any fear or pressure. She has informed that all the disputes

between the parties have been resolved amicably with her free consent and they are living together for the last about three months. She has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled and the complainant is residing with the petitioner in the matrimonial home happily, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to maintain their matrimonial relations, FIR No. 444/2016 registered under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC at PS Bharat Nagar and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner.

4. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
