ORDER
(ORAL)

Petitioners claim that they are working as Guest Teachers for the last 3 to 8 years and they have right to seek regularization of their service in terms of *Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan Bill, 2017*.

Learned counsel for petitioners submits that a concise and composite Representation will be filed on behalf of the petitioners to third respondent- *Directorate of Education* within a week.

If such a Representation is received by third respondent- *Directorate of Education*, then it be considered and decided within four weeks by passing a speaking order and the fate of Representation be

conveyed to Representationist/ petitioners through counsel within a week thereafter, so that petitioners may avail of the remedy as available in law, if need be.

In the facts and circumstances of this case, *status quo* as of today, in respect of petitioners' service be maintained till the fate of Representation is conveyed to them.

With the aforesaid direction, this petition and applications are disposed of.

A copy of this order be given *dasti* under the signatures of Court Master to counsel for the parties.
