1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.301/2017 under Sections 498A/406/377 IPC at PS Rajouri Garden. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondent No.2 vide settlement agreement dated 07.07.2017.

2. Complainant / respondent No.2 is present and has been identified by Investigating Officer. I have enquired from the complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioner amicably without any fear or pressure. She has informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with her free consent and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question. Divorce has already been taken place.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of settlement agreement dated 07.07.2017 has been placed on record. Since the matter has been settled between the parties and the divorce by mutual consent has already been granted, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to settle in life after divorce, FIR No.301/2017 under Sections 498A/406/377 IPC at PS Rajouri Garden and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
