Mr. R.K. Saini, Advocate informs the Court that he has been instructed not to appear in the matter last night. We have asked Mr. Anil Kumar Chandel, Advocate, who is now seeking permission to put his appearance in the matter, as to whether he has taken 'No Objection Certificate' (NOC) from Mr. R.K. Saini, who was earlier appearing in the matter. The answer is in the negative.
