Notice. Learned APP accepts notice for respondent no.1. Respondent no.2 is present in Court and accepts notice. She has been identified by ASI Sahab Singh of police station Saket.

Respondent no.2 submits that she has settled the matter with the petitioner of her own free will and without any undue force, pressure or coercion, therefore, she is not willing to pursue FIR No. 247/2017 under Sections 354/354(A)/354(D)/509/506 IPC registered at police station Saket any further and the same may be quashed.
