Notice. Learned APP accepts notice for respondent no. 1.

Learned APP submits that Mahavir, Raju @ Neelu, Sagar Singh and Geeta had also sustained injuries in the incident but they have not been made a party to this petition.

On the oral prayer made by the learned counsel for petitioner, these persons are impleaded as respondent nos. 3 to 6. Amended memo of parties be filed during the course of the day.

Respondent nos.2 to 6 are present in Court and accept notice. They have been identified by ASI Surender Singh of police station Anand Vihar.

Respondent nos.2 to 6 submit that they have settled the matter with the petitioners of their own free will and without any undue force, pressure or coercion, vide a Compromise Deed dated 25th April, 2014. They submit that they have no objection in case FIR No. 219/2014 under Sections 308/427/506/34 IPC registered at Police Station Anand Vihar and the consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

Keeping in mind the settlement arrived at between the petitioners and respondent nos. 2 to 6 voluntarily, in my view, no fruitful purpose would be served to keep the criminal proceedings pending. Accordingly, in the interest of justice, aforesaid FIR and the consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

Petition is disposed of in the above terms. Dasti.
