1. Issue notice to the respondents. Mr. Angad Mehta accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
2. In view of the limited prayer being made by the petitioners, counsel for the respondents says that he does not wish to file a counter affidavit in the present matter.
3. The relief sought for by the petitioners is that their petition filed with the concerned Tribunal, as far back as on 8.1.2018, has not been taken up for consideration upto now. Counsel for the petitioners says that urgent reliefs are required and therefore, the concerned Tribunal needs to adjudicate upon the petitioners' action preferred under Section 23 of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 (in short 'Act').

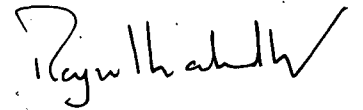
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4. Counsel for the respondents says he cannot but contend that given the circumstances, expedition needs to be shown by the concerned Tribunal.

5. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of with the direction to the Tribunal to take up the petition filed by the petitioner under Section 23 of the Act for consideration. The Tribunal after hearing the concerned parties, will pass a speaking order in the matter.
