**ORDER**  
**(ORAL)**

1. Denial of deputation allowance vide order of 29<sup>th</sup> June, 2011 is assailed in this petition by petitioner-Air India Employees Union.
2. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that despite Representations (*Annexures P-4 to P-6*) made in the years 2016, 2017 and 2018, there is no response by first respondent.
3. Upon hearing and on perusal of impugned order and the material on record, it is deemed appropriate to dispose of this petition with permission to petitioner to make fresh concise Representation to first respondent within two weeks from today. If such a Representation is received by first respondent, then a speaking response be given thereto by

first respondent within a period of eight weeks and its fate be conveyed to petitioner within two weeks thereafter, so that petitioner may avail of the remedies as available in law, if need be.

4. With aforesaid directions, this petition is disposed of.
