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Status report and the nominal roll have been handed over in Court, which are taken on record.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks parole on the ground to re-establish social ties and also challenges the order dated 19th April, 2018 rejecting the application of the petitioner for grant of parole, as the petitioner is a BC of PS Nangloi.

A perusal of the nominal roll reveals that after the application of the petitioner for parole was rejected, petitioner has been granted furlough for a period of two weeks by the Director General (Prisons) with effect from 25th June, 2018 to 09th July, 2018.
