**ORDER**

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**16.05.2018**

1. Present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioners for quashing of FIR No.561/2016 registered under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC at Police Station Shalimar Bagh. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondent No.2 vide

Memorandum of Understanding dated 15.01.2018.

2. Complainant / respondent No.2 is present with her counsel and has been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from the complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioners amicably without any fear or pressure. She has informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with her free consent and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question. Divorce by mutual consent has already been granted. Pursuant to the settlement all payments have been received.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of Memorandum of Understanding dated 15.01.2018 has been placed on record. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to settle in life after divorce, FIR No.561/2016 registered under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC at Police Station Shalimar Bagh, Delhi and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petition and all pending applications stand disposed of accordingly.
