1. Petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.15/2017 initially under Section 363 IPC. Subsequently, Sections 342/506/34 IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act have been added, Police station Najafgarh.
2. It is informed by the learned APP that out of 12 witnesses, 7 have already been examined and only 5 witnesses who are official/formal witnesses are remaining.
