ORDER

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1. By this petition the petitioners had sought a writ of mandamus to the respondent to conduct proper and credible investigation in FIR No. 521/2017 under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC registered at PS Punjabi Bagh, Delhi lodged on the complaint of the wife of the petitioner No.1.
2. The main ground urged in the petition was that the CCTV footage and the transcript of the telephone conversation recorded have not been taken on record during the course of investigation which would prove the innocence of the petitioners.
