ORDER
(ORAL)

1. For the relief claimed in this petition, a Legal Notice (*Annexure P-4*) was sent by petitioners on 5th May, 2018 to second respondent-FCI.
2. Learned counsel for petitioners submits that there is no response to the said Legal Notice (*Annexure P-4*).
3. In the facts and circumstances of this case, it is deemed appropriate to dispose of this petition with direction to second respondent-FCI to treat the said Legal Notice (*Annexure P-4*) as a Representation and pass a speaking order thereon, within a period of eight weeks and convey its fate to petitioners, through the author of Legal Notice/Representation (*Annexure P-4*) within two weeks thereafter, to enable petitioners to have recourse to law, if need be. Till the fate of Legal Notice/Representation

(Annexure P-4) is conveyed to petitioners, through the author of Legal Notice, the seniority in terms of Annexures P-1 & P-2 be not finalized, if not already done.

4. With aforesaid directions, this petition and the application are disposed of.

Copy of this order be given *dasti* to counsels for petitioners and the second respondent-FCI.
