W.P.(CRL) 1663/2018

(1) Present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been preferred by the petitioner for quashing of FIR No.1817/15 under Section 135/138 of Indian Electricity Act registered at Police Station Neb Sarai. It is stated that the matter has been settled with the complainant/respondent No.2 amicably.

(2) Learned counsel for respondent No.2 is present before the Court. I have enquired from him whether the matter has been settled with the petitioner amicably. He has informed that the matter has been settled and all agreed dues have been paid, and he has no objection to the quashing of the FIR.

(3) The petition is supported by the affidavits of the petitioner and 'no due certificate' issued by respondent No.2/BSES.

(4) Since the complainant/Respondent No.2 has voluntarily settled the dispute with the petitioner and the petitioner has paid the dues, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to put an end to the litigation, FIR No.1817/15 under Section 135/138 of Indian Electricity Act registered at Police Station Neb Sarai and all the proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

(5) The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
