**ORDER**

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1. By this petition, petitioner seeks parole on the ground that he has to undertake examination and negotiate the marriage proposal of his daughter who is now 30 years old.
2. A status report has been handed over which is taken on record. As per the status report the elder daughter of the petitioner is aged 30 years and the son is aged 27 years. Both the children are unmarried.
