**CM APPL 22497/2018 (for condonation of delay)**

In view of the averments made in the application, the delay of 249 days in filing the appeal is condoned. Application stands disposed of.

**CM APPL 22499/2018 (exemption)**

Allowed subject to all just exceptions. Application stands disposed of.

**LPA 307/2018 & CM APPL 22498/2018 (stay)**

Government of NCT of Delhi is aggrieved by learned Single Judge's orders in writ proceedings; learned Single Judge has directed the consideration of the respondent's application for allotment of alternative plot. The main ground urged is that the application was made beyond the stipulated period. Learned Single Judge in the

course of hearing assessed the facts and noted that the request/application for allotment was made barely four days after the date or period prescribed in the notification. Furthermore, the notification was not statutory. Obviously the period could not be considered un-extendable in these circumstances.

There is no merit in the appeal; accordingly it is dismissed.
