Notice. Learned APP accepts notice for respondent no. 1.
Respondent no.2 Ms. Benazir Sahil is present in Court along with her
counsel and accepts notice. She has been identified by ASI Anil Kumar of
police station Aman Vihar.

Respondent no.2 submits that she has settled the matter with the
petitioners of her own free will and without any undue force, pressure or
coercion before Delhi Mediation Centre, Rohini District Courts, Delhi on
10th May, 2018. Respondent no. 2 says that she has no objection in case FIR
No. 786/2014 under Sections 323/352/354/509/34 IPC registered at Police

Station Aman Vihar and the consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed. Affidavit of respondent no. 2 to this effect is also on record at pages 13-14.

Keeping in mind the settlement arrived at between the petitioners and respondent no. 2 voluntarily, in my view, no fruitful purpose would be served to keep the criminal proceedings pending. Accordingly, in the interest of justice, aforesaid FIR and the consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

Petition is disposed of in the above terms. Miscellaneous application is disposed of as infructuous. Dasti.
