Ms. Vohra, learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State has sought to place on record the further status report. It is taken on record.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that against the sentence of seven years, vide judgment dated 08.04.2016, the petitioner has already undergone the judicial custody of more than five and half years and by the instant application, he seeks parole to attend the marriage of his younger sister, which is verified to be scheduled on 30th June 2018.
