By these applications, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case
FIR No. 176/2018 under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC registered at Police
Station – Hari Nagar, Delhi.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that some matrimonial dispute arose between the parties which led to the registration of the FIR in the instant case.
