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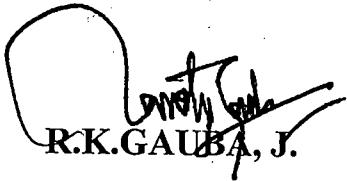
The petition and the applications filed therewith clearly have been rendered infructuous and are dismissed accordingly.
