Mr. Sanjoy Ghose, learned Additional Standing Counsel appearing on behalf of the GNCTD accepts notice. Ms. Eshita Baruah, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent No. 3 accepts notice.

Mr. Sanjoy Ghose, learned ASG for the GNCTD states that they shall treat the present petition and its annexures as a representation and determine it expeditiously, after affording a reasonable opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, in accordance with law.

With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of. Pending application also stands disposed of.
