The present petition instituted on behalf of the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is not being entertained at this juncture, in view of the circumstance that the subject premises, of which de-sealing is sought, has been sealed by the Municipal Corporation of Delhi, on the directions of the Monitoring Committee, constituted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, before whom the issue is pending.
