Notice. Respondent nos.2 and 3 are present in Court and accept notice. They have been identified by SI Ranbir Singh of police station Badarpur.

Respondent nos.2 and 3 submit that they have settled the matter with the petitioners of their own free will and without any undue force, pressure or coercion, vide a Settlement Deed dated 7th May, 2018. Respondent nos. 2 and 3 also submit that they have received compensation of ₹1,25,000/- jointly from the petitioners towards the medical expenses and mental pain &

agony suffered by them. Respondent nos. 2 and 3 say that they have no objection in case FIR no. 97/2015 under Sections 323/307/34 IPC registered at Police Station Badarpur and consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed against the petitioners.

Keeping in mind the settlement arrived at between the petitioners and respondent nos. 2 and 3 voluntarily, in my view, no fruitful purpose would be served to keep the criminal proceedings pending. Accordingly, in the interest of justice, aforesaid FIR and consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

Petition is disposed of in the above terms. Dasti.
