**ORDER**  
**20.08.2018**

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The petitioner, who is undergoing life imprisonment, seeks parole to meet his mother, a 58 year old lady, who lives alone. The petitioner's residential address in Delhi has been verified as E-25, Ground Floor, Khasra No. 35/2017, Brahmpuri, Phase-2, Nangloi, P.S. Ranhola, Delhi instead of L-25, Ground Floor, Khasra No. 35/2017, Brahmpuri, Phase-2, Nangloi, P.S. Ranhola, Delhi as mentioned in the petition; his mother is residing at the said address. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the house number mentioned in the petition as - L-25 be read as – E-25.

In view of the foregoing, the Court finds no impediment in allowing the present petition. Consequently, the petitioner is enlarged on parole for a

period of four weeks from the date of his release on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.10,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Jail Superintendent concerned, subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) The petitioner shall report to the SHO, concerned Police Station Preet Vihar, Delhi, once a week on every Tuesday during the period of parole.
- (2) He shall furnish his telephone number to the SHO concerned, which the petitioner shall keep operational at all times
- (3) He shall not leave the territory of NCT of Delhi.
- (4) The petitioner shall surrender before the Jail Authorities at the expiry of the period of parole.

With the above directions the writ petition is disposed off.
